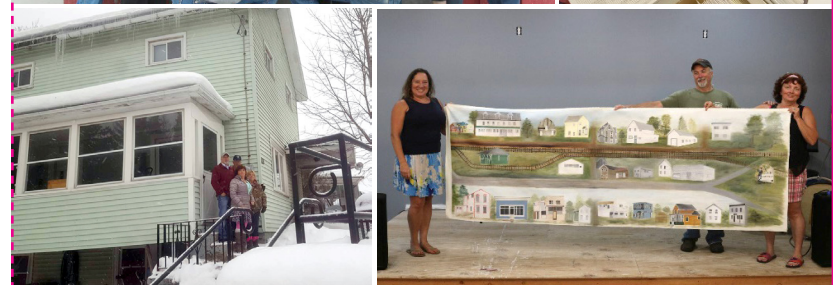

Ministries of The Master's Plan

Our "Food Pantry" serves over 4,500 meals a month helping families from Dayton and surrounding areas.

Food Express Truck – Through the help of The WNY Food bank and local farmers we are serving 150 families each month.

Our "Senior Citizens" gather at the café every other Thursday. For some it is their only social event. They continue to bring surprises, historical views, and joy every time we gather.

Our "Love to spare" helps numerous families with clothes, furniture, and several house-hold items. And sometimes just a homemade baked pie to brighten someone's day. Thank you to **Dr. Lyle F. Renodin Foundation** and the **Franciscan Sisters of Alleghany** for their ongoing support of this outreach.

Our "Little Foot Prints" – We supply children and adults with NEW shoes, boots, and sneakers as supplies are available.

Our **Clean, Sober, and Saved** Program, each Friday evening at 7pm. We work hand in hand with addicts and the Family of addicts, with xxxxxxxx

We work collaboratively with **Love Inc.** in Gowanda and many churches in our community in various areas, with food, clothing, and furniture.

Our "Community Service Program" – We work closely with Cattaraugus County Probation office, which sends people to our ministry for community service. We take this opportunity to teach Biblical truth, while educating a better way of life. Without using substances, we have lead people to Jesus and they are now regularly involved with the Ministry.

Our "Community Gathering Place" – There are family reunions, baby showers, picnics and weddings. The gardens provide a back drop for wedding and graduation pictures. Some in the community come simply to sit. We provide Memorial Service Dinners at the café.

Our "Emergency Housing" continues to help many families each year.

We host an annual **Motorcycle Dice Run**, (August 11th) our annual **Community Days**, Car show and BBQ, (July 11th) with entertainment, raffles and **AMERICAN auction baskets**, while providing places for vendors.

We are part of the **Cattaraugus County Geocaching** which will continue throughout the winter. We have partnered with Cattaraugus County as a member of the Amish Trail.

Our "Harvest Celebration" – October 31st - We serve Chili and Hot Dogs to all who come. Playing games, sharing material about Christ along with cookie and pumpkin decorating.

Our "Unplanned Events/ Benefits" – Chicken BBQ's, soup and salad lunches, spaghetti dinners, to help raise funds for multiple devastation, fires, medical necessities, life altering events, to name a few.

Our "Giving Back Event" Thanksgiving Dinners - We serve dinners each Friday after Thanksgiving from 11-5pm, free to all that attend. Dinners are available for in-house, take-out and some are delivered to house bound people.

We prepare **CHRISTmas Boxes of LOVE**, which consist of groceries to cook a CHRISTmas meal. This also includes gifts for the whole household.
